Re: Neighbourhood Plan for Gaddesby Parish Council

I am writing to you as a stakeholder who has an interest in Gaddesby to advise you that the Parish Council has taken the decision to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan.

The area covered by the Parish Council, including the villages of Gaddesby, Barsby and Ashby Folville has been designated by Melton Borough Council as a 'Neighbourhood Area' in accordance with Part 2 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

It is anticipated that this process will be concluded within the next 18 months or so and over the coming weeks and months we will be promoting the Plan with the local community and arranging consultation events to which you can take part and be involved. You will be able to find out more about the Neighbourhood Planning process and have your say about how Gaddesby should look in the coming years at these events.

The Neighbourhood Plan will establish planning policies that are likely to cover issues such as housing; environment; economic development; community facilities; heritage; leisure and transport.

At this stage, I would be grateful for your acknowledgement of this letter; to receive an early indication from you as to whether you have any issues that you would like the Neighbourhood Plan to specifically address and confirmation that you are the most appropriate person to contact within your organisation for Neighbourhood Planning purposes.

I look forward to hearing from you in relation to these issues and to keeping you in touch with developments as the process continues.
