- Local Plan (Response received - ID: ANON-MWX6-MJEB-G)
 - The very strong evidence of recent history is that Melton housing growth has led to increasingly unaffordable housing, increased homelessness and greater inequality
 - The Local Plan continues to drive growth purely to support Gov.UK policy as opposed to local need; the population was stable between 2011 and 2021
