



# Melton Borough Local Plan

## 2011 - 2036

On the 10th October 2018, Melton Borough Council resolved to formally adopt the Melton Borough Local Plan 2011-2036 (MLP). The MLP provides a plan for the development and infrastructure needs of the area, and sets key priorities and objectives. There have been numerous consultations with residents, developers and government agencies over the period of developing the plan.

The MLP was subject to examination by an independent inspector appointed by the Secretary of State, who issued her report on the 14th September 2018. The Report concluded that, subject to the Main Modifications, the Local Plan was sound and legally compliant and capable of adoption. These Modifications have been included in the adopted Melton Borough Local Plan.

Any person aggrieved by the Melton Borough Local Plan 2011-2036 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that: the Local Plan is not within the appropriate powers or a procedural requirement of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Regulations has not been complied with. All applications need to be made no later than Friday 23rd November 2018.
