

Dear Sirs,

I have just been made aware of the above which states that the Council has decided to identify the extensive land area which includes or borders the villages of Great Dalby, Thorpe Satchville, Ashby Folville, Barsby, Gaddesby, Kirby Bellars and Burton Lazars as suitable for wind farms comprising four or five turbines each up to 50 meters in height - referring to this land area as LCU8.

I object to this and request that this be removed from the Draft Local Plan.

This is an area of great NATURAL beauty and the prominence of wind turbines would impact greatly on the quality of life and the reason people live and visit the countryside.
