

I have been made aware of an apparent error to Page 50 Environment Fig. 4 - OTHER SITES OF NATURAL AND HISTORICAL ENVIRONMENT SIGNIFICANCE

Although indistinct, and missed by previous inspections, this map appears to show a plot of land that the property 26 Church Lane, Long Clawson LE14 4ND, is already built on, has been ecologically surveyed with no significant findings, and currently has two planning permissions for it's development. The inclusion of this developed site seems at odds with the other area's that do not appear to show any development or properties indicated by way of the blue tint.

To Quote:-

POLICY ENV 2: OTHER SITES OF ENVIRONMENTAL (NATURAL AND HISTORICAL) SIGNIFICANCE - The sites indicated on the map below (Environment Fig. 4) and detailed in Supporting Evidence CHH NP Inventory for Sites have been identified as being of local significance for wildlife (biodiversity) and/or history. They are important in their own right and are locally valued. The protection and enhancement of the identified significant features will be supported. Any harm arising from a development proposal, or a change of land use requiring planning approval, will need to be balanced against their significance as sites of environmental significance.

The map is not distinct, copy below, but if it does include 26 Church Lane then I fail to see how this can be measured by any of the above criteria.

I request that this error is attended to and the map is amended to remove the plot of land that is known by the address of 26 Church Lane, Long Clawson, LE14 4ND.
