



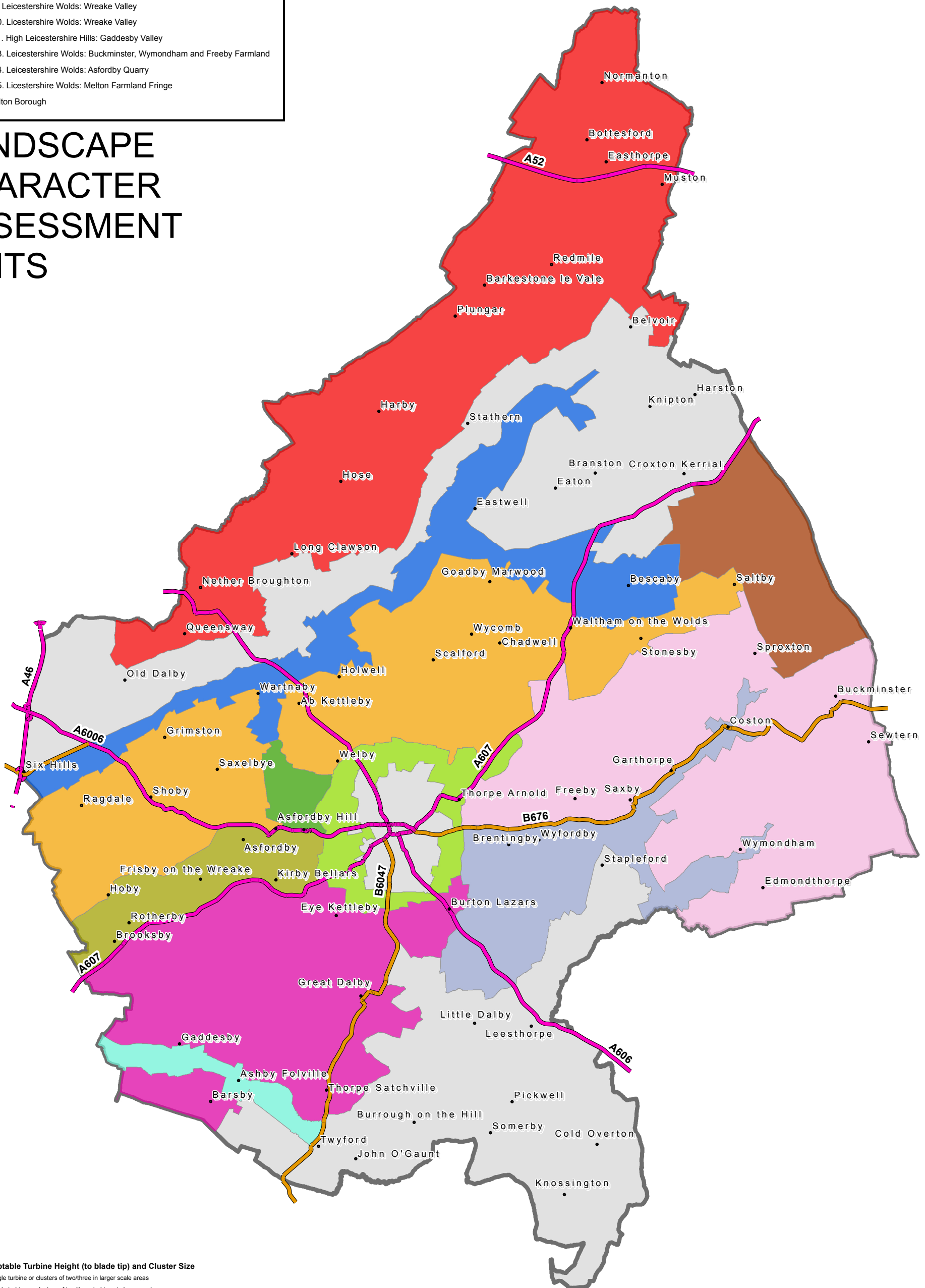

LANDSCAPE CHARACTER ASSESSMENT UNITS



Maximum Acceptable Turbine Height (to blade tip) and Cluster Size

- <25m as a single turbine or clusters of two/three in larger scale areas
- <25m as a single turbine or clusters of two/three turbines in larger scale areas
- <25m as a single turbine in the smaller vales or two/three turbines in elevated areas
- Up to 75m as clusters of two/three turbines in wooded areas or clusters of four/five in open arable areas
- Up to 50m as clusters of four/five turbines and in areas of varied, steeply sloping topography and small field patterns clusters of two/three
- <25m as clusters of two/three turbines
- <25m as a single turbine in the east of the area and two/three turbines in the west
- <25m as clusters of two/three turbines
- Up to 50m as clusters of two/three turbines
- Up to 50m in clusters of four/five turbines
- Up to 5m as clusters of two/three turbines
