Policy EN4 is a very important policy for village communities and has the support of residents.  However, to carry any weight it should be clear. The zig-zag lines used to indicate Areas of Separation in the <i>Melton Borough Areas of Separation, Settlement Fringe Sensitivity and Local Green Space Study (Influence, 2015)</i> should not be repeated in the Local Plan documents but should be replaced by clearly delineated areas that indicate exactly 'what will be permitted and where".  This should particularly apply to Figure 7, The Southern Sustainable Neighbourhood Concept Map in Chapter 8 which presently indicates substantial encroachment of development into two Areas of Separation by both housing and employment land.
